

Punjab State Council for Agricultural Education, Punjab

The Sri Guru Granth Sahib World University, Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) has submitted Compliance Report to meet the minimum standards required for starting B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) programme to the Punjab State Council for Agricultural Education. The compliance report was found in order and, thereafter, the sub-committee constituted by the Punjab State Council for Agricultural Education visited the University and found that this institution fulfils the minimum requirements for undertaking B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) programme. On this basis, the Council considers SGGSW University Fatehgarh Sahib eligible and approves the starting of B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) 4 year programme with a batch of 60 students for next five years with effect from 2023-24.

The Council further decides that if any deviation is found in the number of students admitted in the B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) programme or any other deviation with regard to compliance to the minimum standards required for undertaking B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) programme, as approved by the Council, this permission shall stand withdrawn with immediate effect. In such a situation, Sri Guru Granth Sahib World University, Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) shall not be eligible for making any further admission of students to the B.Sc. Agriculture (Honours) programme. The Sri Guru Granth Sahib World University, Fatehgarh Sahib (Punjab) has to always meet the minimum standards for faculty positions, laboratories, agricultural land and other conditions, as specified by the Punjab State Council for Agricultural Education, at present, or modified from time to time.
