Report

An anti-ragging campaign was held on **August 8th, 2025**, from **10:00 AM to 12:00 PM**. The session was organized to spread awareness about the harmful effects of ragging and to encourage a culture of respect and safety in the institution.

- **Details:** The event included speeches by faculty members, along with a slogan writing competition where participants shared the importance of an anti-ragging environment through their creative work.
- **Opening Address:** The event started with an opening speech by Kirandeep Kaur, who spoke about the importance of ending ragging in educational institutions. She explained how ragging can hurt students emotionally and mentally, and how its effects can last for a long time.

- **Slogan writing Competition:** As part of the campaign, a slogan writing competition was held. Students made slogans showing the importance of an anti-ragging culture. The aim was to encourage students to express, in a creative way, their support for a safe and respectful campus. The slogans were very thoughtful and creative, which made it difficult to judge. The best slogans were chosen by Dr. Puneet Kaur and Dr. Falak Thakral based on creativity, relevance, and clarity of the message
- The winners were:

- **Closing Remarks:** The campaign ended with closing remarks by Dr. Rupinder Kaur [Head of Department], who reminded everyone that the institution has a strict zero-tolerance policy against ragging.
